is a transitional living and support services program for youth experiencing homelessness.

Eligibility

Young adults (ages 18-21) who are low income and homeless.

Services

- Transitional housing for up to 21 months
- Weekly Case Management
- Substances Abuse Counseling
- Mentoring
- Mental Health Counseling
- Life Skills Classes
- After Care Services
- Assessments
- Supportive Services
- Referral, resources and linkage to community services

Cost

There is no cost for services. However, donations are welcome and necessary to keep program services available for young adults.
